Churches, schools and choral groups are invited to encourage members of their choir, congregation and students who are over the age of 16 to be sponsored by local businesses, friends and family to represent their school/group in a Mass Choir of 3000 voices at the **Royal Albert Hall on Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2007**. The occasion is **“Football Reaching Out For Africa”(FROFA)**, a charity event to be produced by **Major Sir Michael Parker KCVO CBE**, with **Thierry Henry** who will be presenting the **Thierry Henry Young Achiever Award**, Lauren of Arsenal FC and a host of International Football Stars and Celebrities, which will raise money for the building of Clinics/Healthcare Centres all over Africa. The School's or Group's Logo or name will be included in the Events glassy programme.

To take part, each person must raise at least £25. Details of the items to be sung will be sent to you in advance. Almost all will be songs you already know and your choir will need to rehearse them in advance as the only time the whole 3000-strong choir will come together to rehearse will be on the day of the event – **Sunday 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2007**. We regret that we cannot invite individuals to take part – administratively and from the point of view of rehearsals it is not feasible. Ideally we would like you to get together groups of 30 people and over but we will consider smaller groups.

The 3000 strong choir that took part in *“Reaching out for Africa”- 2002* with students from Stagecoach Theatre School, who went on to form part of the mass 5000 Golden Jubilee Gospel Choir organised by **Patti Boulaye**, which led **HM The Queen** into The Mall during the Golden Jubilee Celebrations produced by **Major Sir Michael Parker** on 4 June 2002.

We are expecting a big response, given the success of our last Royal Albert Hall Event with 3000 gospel singers, so we recommend you register as soon as possible.
